# **Welcome Back**

#### **End of Day Routines in the Junior Department**

The end of the day is very busy and we want to keep our children safe. Only Y6 children will be allowed to walk home with their parents' permission. This means all other children must be collected from the playground. If there is somebody new collecting your child, please let us know by phoning the school office. Please do not gather at the car park gates and signal to your child to walk up to you-teachers will not release them. You must use the one-way system using the main gate and collect your child from their class line. Parents who need to pick up their child from the main office can continue to do so. Thanks for your support with this matter.

#### **PE Kits**

Just a reminder that PE lessons have started and all children need to have their PE kits in school each week. The school PE kit is a plain white t-shirt, navy/ black shorts and pumps/trainers (navy/black leggings and jogging bottoms can be worn in winter.) No earrings to be worn on PE days. Please can you check that all school uniform is labelled, including PE kits. Children misplace things and without labels it is very difficult to find.

There is a sports activity every lunchtime in KS2 for children to participate in. Children need a pair of trainers or school pumps in school if they wish to participate. Please make sure the PE kit bag contains trainers or PE pumps.

Please phone the school office each morning if your child is going to be absent from school. Thanks for your support with this.

#### **School Dinners and Healthy Lunchtime**

We encourage all children to eat a healthy meal at lunch time. If your child brings in a packed lunch, please remember no fizzy drinks and sweets.

If your child is on school dinners, please ensure your order and pay for your child's meals on the School Grid for the week ahead. The children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal but you must order this on School Grid.

#### **Virtues and Values**

This term we are growing to be Grateful and Generous. We will be promoting these values in school through our collective worship and in discussions with the children. Each week a child in each class will be chosen for a special certificate for using these values.
