




We eventually managed to celebrate NSPCC Number Day on 7th May (due to the lockdown) – it was worth the wait...and we raised £179.20


Our Nursery home learners enjoyed taking part in number fun activities. They played “hook a duck bingo” in their Zoom session and went on a number hunt around their homes.






Year 1 loved playing, “Guess my Number” games and then...ate their winning number.
